Call to Order

TLWI Logo Proposals

After some discussion it was suggested that the TLWI might provide containers where ice fishers could place garbage. Bernie Lukan and Doug Fischer volunteered to investigate some container types along with the related costs.

Merv Swanson informed the group that RAN has suggested that the north end of Turtle Lake be designated as a representative area and work is already underway. Terry asked if they might be approached to be a presenter at the AGM and Merv said that he would contact them to determine their availability.
